



**EMPORIA STATE UNIVERSITY  
NAMED SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES  
2010 – 2011 UNIVERSITY YEAR**

**Emporia State University (ESU) School of Business agrees to provide five (10) scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each to Youth Entrepreneurs Kansas (YEK) to be awarded to eligible students as determined by the YEK organization. The following terms and conditions apply:**

1. Scholarship(s) will be awarded annually to a student(s) enrolled full or part time at ESU majoring in business.
2. Scholarship(s) is valid for the 2010-2011 school year and may be distributed during the fall, spring or summer semester.
3. No recipient will be excluded from consideration based on race, religion, color, national origin, gender, age, sexual orientation, marital status, status as a veteran or disability.
4. Recipients must be graduates of the YEK program. YEK graduates are eligible up to 22 years of age.
5. Scholarships are contingent upon available funds from ESU. YEK will contact ESU annually to verify availability of funds.
6. Recipient recommendation(s) will be submitted by YEK in writing before March 31 and should include all relevant student contact information and full scholarship application. ESU will make final determination to grant scholarship(s).
7. The scholarship office at ESU will administer the scholarship(s) and make the award(s) based on recommendations submitted by YEK.
8. Student should contact the Associate Dean of the Business School to redeem scholarship.
9. Recipients will receive an official award letter from ESU.
10. The scholarship(s) will not be automatically renewed, but students are welcome to reapply according to YEK scholarship guidelines.
