



**WASHBURN UNIVERSITY  
NAMED SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES  
2010-2011 UNIVERSITY YEAR**

**Washburn University (Washburn) agrees to provide three (3) scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 to Youth Entrepreneurs Kansas (YEK) to be awarded to an eligible student(s) as determined by the YEK organization. The following terms and conditions apply:**

1. Scholarship will be awarded annually to a student enrolled full time at Washburn who is declared in a business related field.
2. Scholarship is valid for the 2010-2011 academic year and will be split equally between the fall and spring semesters.
3. No recipient will be excluded from consideration based on race, religion, color, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, status as a veteran or disability.
4. Recipients must be graduates of the YEK program. YEK graduates are eligible up to 22 years of age.
5. Scholarships are contingent upon available funds from Washburn. YEK will contact Washburn annually to verify availability of funds.
6. Recipient recommendation(s) will be submitted by YEK in writing before March 31 and should include all relevant student contact information.
7. The Financial Aid office at Washburn will administer the scholarship and make the award based on recommendations submitted by YEK. Scholarship will be applied to student account and has no cash value.
8. Recipients will receive an official award notification letter from Washburn. The scholarship must be officially accepted, directions will be provided on the award notification letter. All questions about the acceptance process should be directed towards Stacy Woltje, Academic Advisor for the School of Business at Washburn.
9. The scholarship will not be automatically renewed, but students are welcome to reapply according to YEK scholarship guidelines.
