NAMED SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES
2010-2011 UNIVERSITY YEAR**

Wichita State University W. Frank Barton School of Business Center for Entrepreneurship (WSU) agrees to provide one (1) scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to Youth Entrepreneurs Kansas (YEK) to be awarded to eligible students as determined by the YEK organization. The following terms and conditions apply:

1. One scholarship will be awarded annually to a student enrolled full or part time at Wichita State University in the W. Frank Barton School of Business, majoring in Entrepreneurship.
2. Scholarship is valid for the 2010-2011 academic year and will be split equally between the fall and spring semesters.
3. No recipient will be excluded from consideration based on race, religion, color, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, status as a veteran or disability.
4. Recipients must be graduates of the YEK program. YEK graduates are eligible up to 22 years of age.
5. Scholarships are contingent upon available funds from the Center for Entrepreneurship, W. Frank Barton School of Business. YEK will contact the Center for Entrepreneurship via email (annually, in December) to verify availability of funds.
6. Recipient recommendation will be submitted by YEK with an email by March 1st and should include the student's name, mailing address, contact phone number, and WSU student ID (if available).
7. The Scholarship Office, a department within the Division of Campus Life and University Relations of Wichita State University, will administer the scholarship and make the award based on recommendations submitted by YEK, through the Center for Entrepreneurship, W. Frank Barton School of Business.
8. Recipients will receive an official award notification letter from WSU.
9. The scholarship will not be automatically renewed, but students are welcome to reapply according to YEK scholarship guidelines.
